Risk Assessment as compiled by the duly appointed Risk Assessment Officers who are the lead Councillors in respect of the field for the Parish Council

The playground equipment, consisting of storm shoot, double wooden frame cradle seat swings, tornado carousel, eco hogs back, eco cheddar gorge, eco amazon basin, eco Niagara fall, eco Stonehenge, eco pillars of Hercules, spinner, toddler slide, 2nd wooden double frame swing, 2 timber picnic benches and 2 five aside goal posts, is fully DD compliant and was installed A ROSPA inspector completed a post-installation inspection and certification. in 2008. There is safety fencing around the toddlers’ area and separate fencing at the 5-Aside football pitch. Since 2008 the following equipment has been installed:- 1 kangaroo springer, 1 bike springer, 1 roundabout, 1 multi-use Goalmouth and basket ball post, 1 cone climber and 1 overhead rotator which presently has had the working top removed for safety reasons. Dog-waste and litter bins have been installed and are emptied regularly.

The lead Councillors visually inspect the Playing Field on a weekly basis and duly record these visits.

The Council employs HAGS to inspect the site quarterly and in 2017 remedial work was carried out on their advice.

The Parish Council employs an outside company for grounds maintenance during the year as and when required.

The Playing Field is the property of the Charnwood Borough Council

The Parish Council has a mandatory cover for public liability of not less than £10 million.
