

## **Cemetery on Groby Lane Newtown Linford Leicester**

Risk assessment as compiled by the Newtown Linford Parish Council for the Cemetery on Groby Lane Newtown Linford Leicester. The Cemetery is controlled by the Rules and Regulations booklet published separately and approved and amended by the Council during the year if appropriate.

The Parish Council employ an independent contractor to look after ground maintenance throughout the growing season. During the winter the cemetery is regularly inspected and anything untoward dealt with on an as and when basis.

The Parish Council no longer own mowers, hedge trimmers, strimmers or any other gardening equipment.

No petrol, oil fertilizer (liquid or otherwise) is kept in the Cemetery shed or elsewhere.

Dead plants, flowers and wreaths are removed by an independent contractor for fortnightly collection by the Refuse Collectors employed by Charnwood Borough Council. Grass cuttings are removed by the grounds maintenance company.

All gravestones are limited to a height of 2'6" including the plinth. There are no stone surrounds. The memorials are set in lawn which is cut regularly.

The shed which incorporates a bench and several memorial seats are checked regularly and at least fortnightly for repairs and maintenance.

The Parish Council has mandatory cover for public liability of not less than £10 million.
