LCC Highways advise issue has now been added to Edging Back Schedule for completion before the end of February '20 and will request an Inspector visits 09/01/20.

- Bradgate Road VAS sign – Intermittent ‘no display’ issues. Possible issues with low light levels.
- Suggestion of ‘No Vehicles Accept for Access’ signs from resident for Bracken Hill, submitted to Ann Carruthers, Director of Environment and Transport at LCC, via CC N Rushton 03/01/20. Team Manager Fiona Blockley to liaise with Parish Council regarding Resident Traffic Survey results.
- Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders planned for:
  - a) Ulverscroft Lane - One day closure on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2020 to undertake tree cutting works.
  - b) Slip Road from A50 Markfield Road to and from Newtown Linford Lane, Groby / Groby Lane, Newtown Linford – One overnight closure on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2020 to facilitate carriageway patching and other highway works.
  - c) Joe Moores Lane – Two day closure commencing 26<sup>th</sup> February 2020 to undertake forestry works.
